
Teacher: Ravi, what is this?

Teacher: Right. Can this doll walk?


Ravi: No, it cannot walk.

Children: Yes, Teacher.




Teacher: Why can a doll not see, eat, or drink? Is the doll different from us? Ravi, Can you tell me that?


Ravi: We have a life, but the doll is only a toy.
