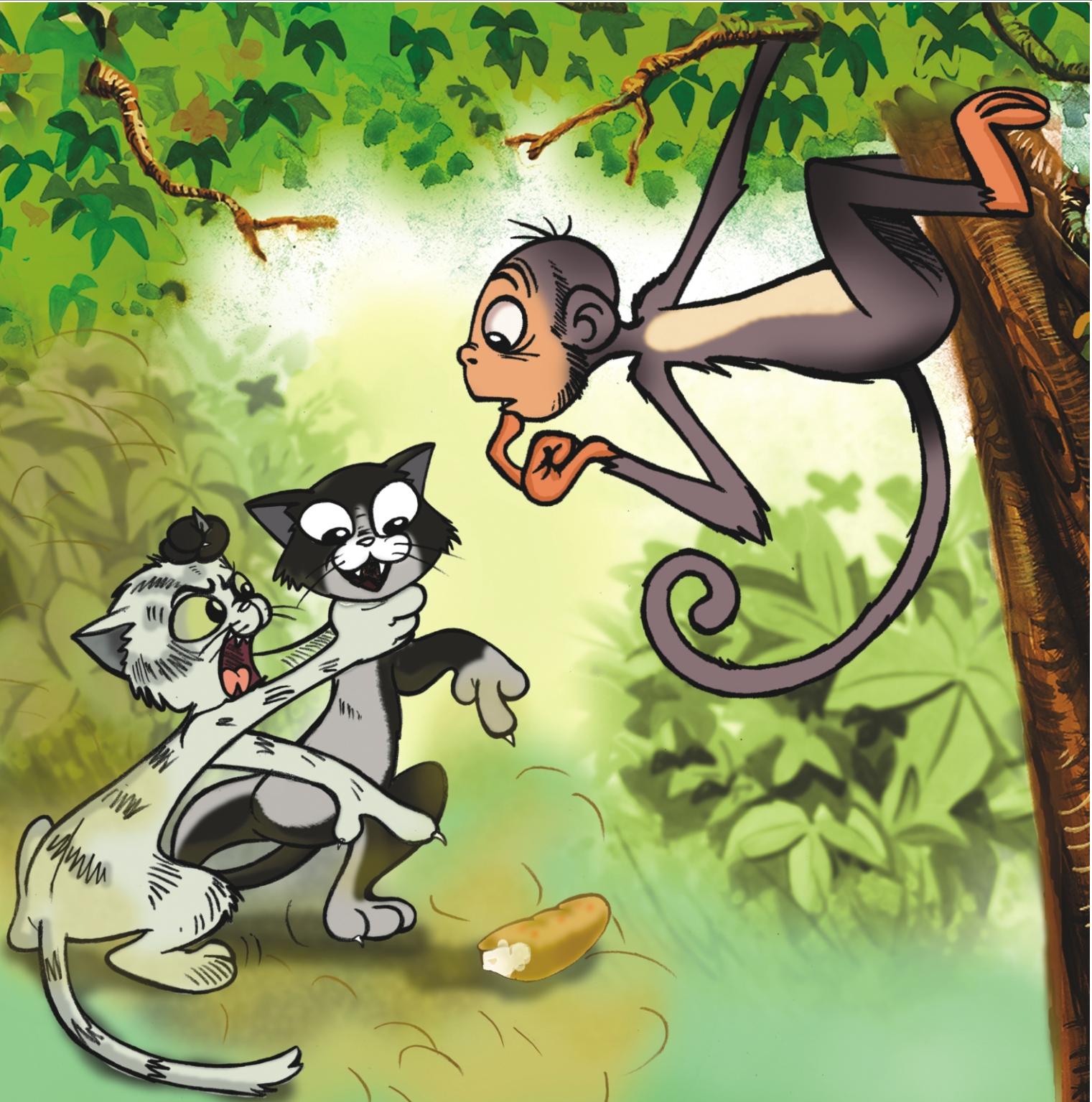
Two Fighting Cats
