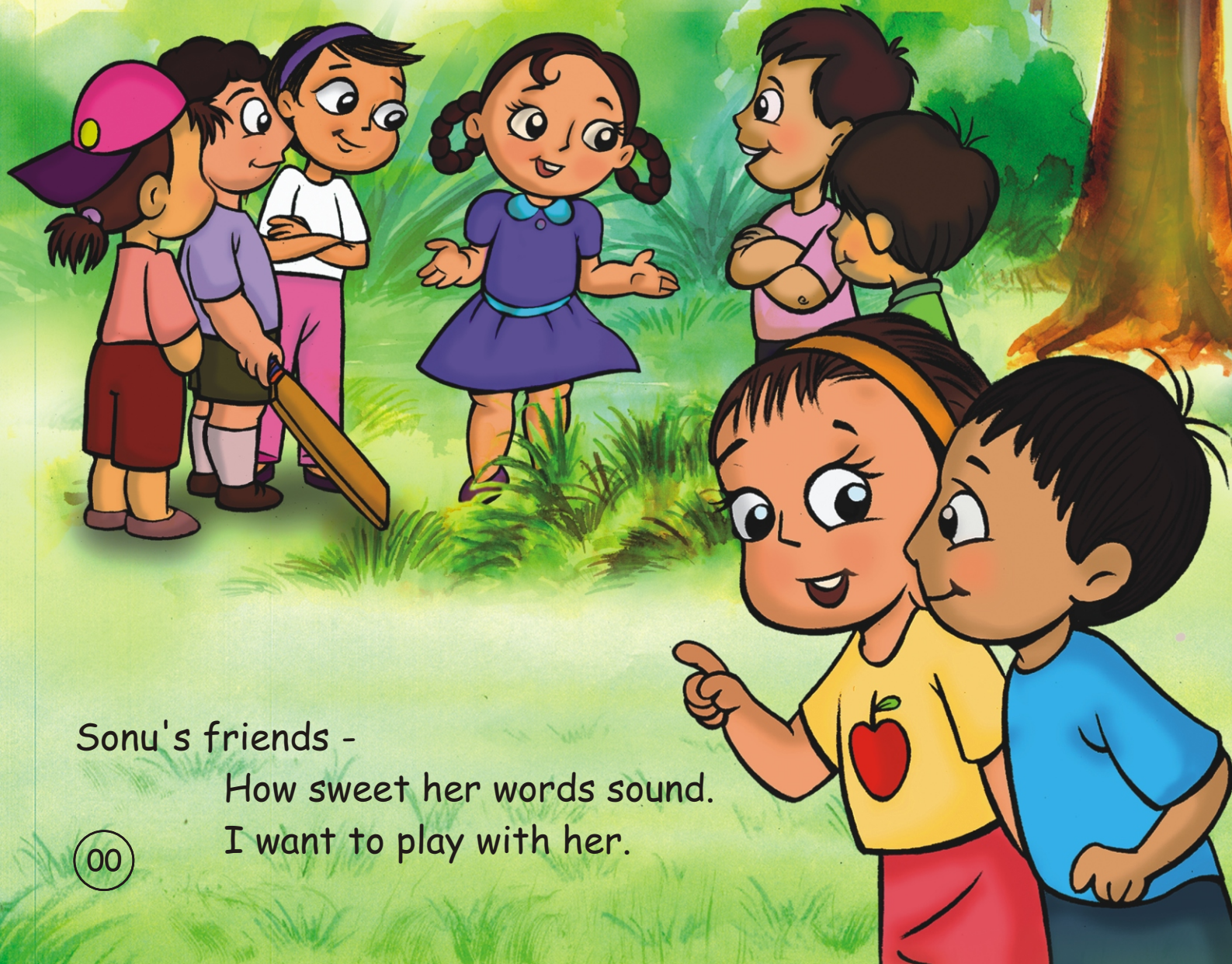





Sonu - I like speaking

If you met her, She'd put you in a bad mood!

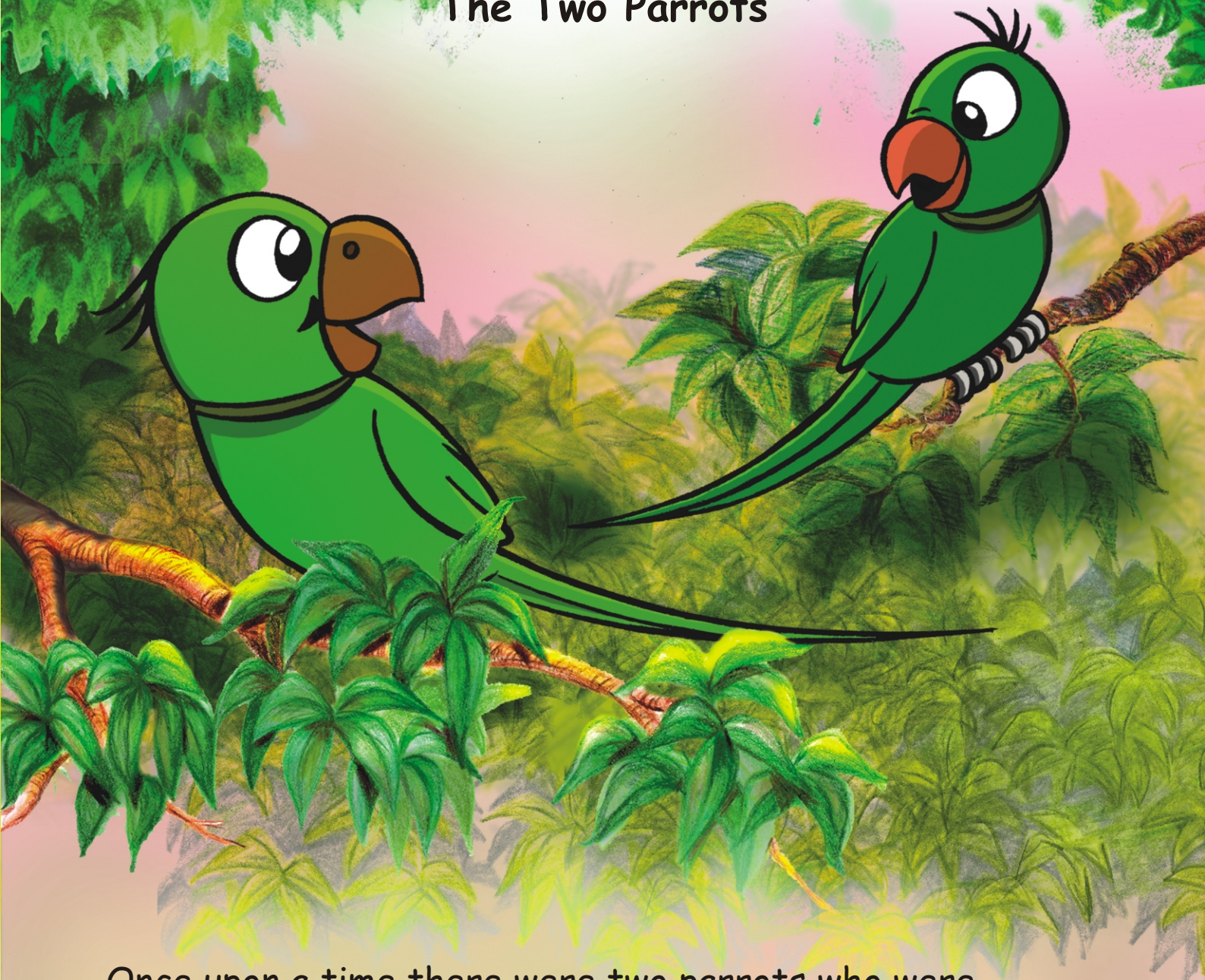
No one ever spoke to her,

Once upon a time there were two parrots who were brothers. One was called Mithu the other Titu. They went to live with two different families.



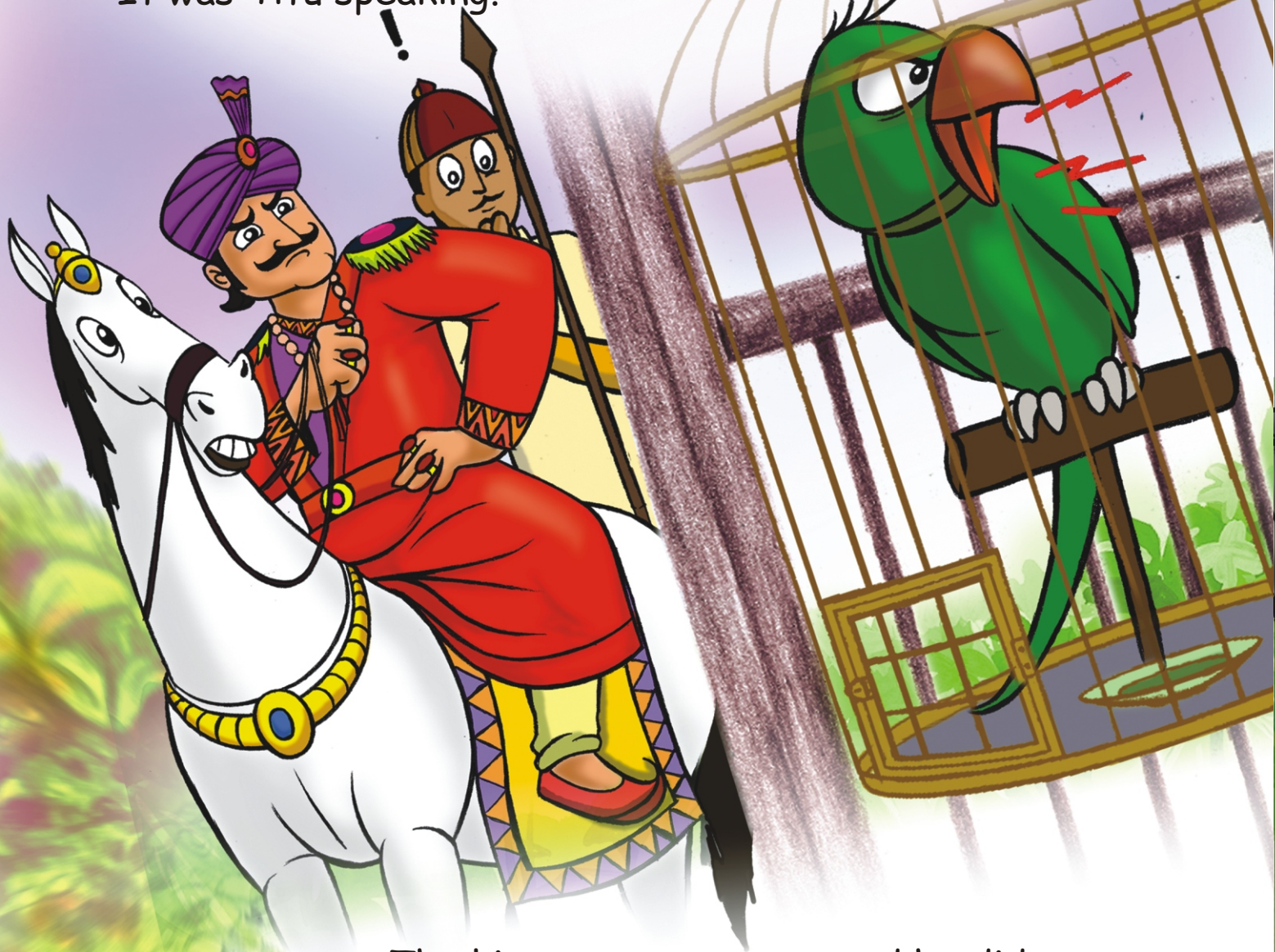
Mithu went to live with a very polite family.
