They smell nice too!




Chunni Has A Bath

For two whole days Chunni just wouldn't have a bath.

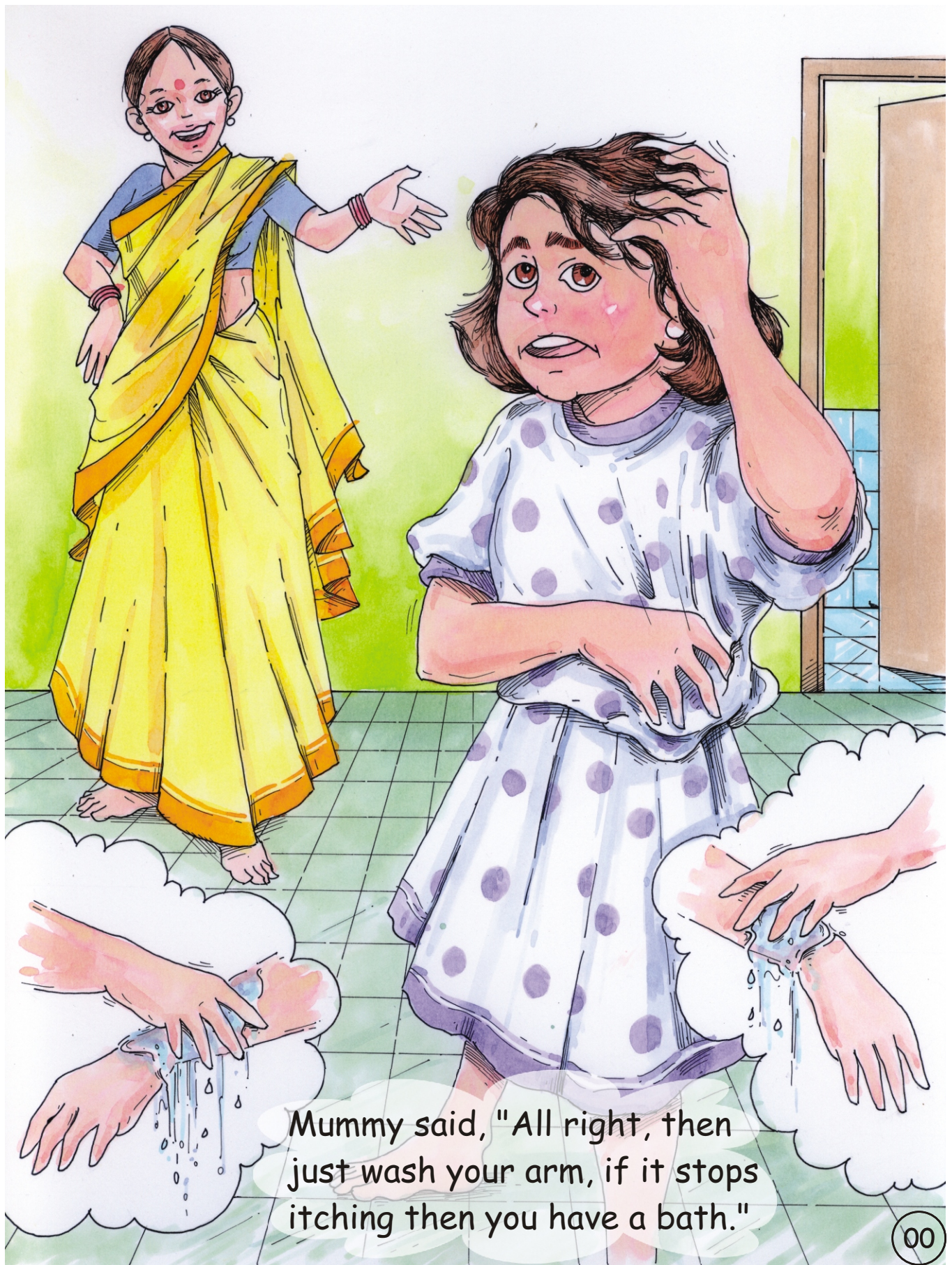
One day Chunni felt itchy.
